About STEM designation

All Gies graduate programs are STEM-designated. A STEM designation is a label given to certain academic programs in the United States by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) in fields related to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).

Students who graduate from STEM-designated degree programs are eligible for certain benefits, such as an extension of their Optional Practical Training (OPT) work authorization. OPT is a program that allows international students to work in the United States after graduation. With a STEM-designated graduate degree, students can extend their OPT for an additional 24 months, helping them gain more hands-on experience working in the United States.












